

Computer Use Policy

of Grinnell Library

At Grinnell Library we are always working hard to provide our patrons with a safe and efficient computing environment.

Please be advised that patrons who use the Library's computer equipment must abide by the Grinnell Library Computer Use Policy which prohibits:

1. Eating, drinking, using cell phones, or engaging in loud or disruptive behavior
2. Sending, receiving, or displaying text and graphics which may reasonably be construed by the library staff as being offensive to the public
3. Making unauthorized changes to the set-up or configuration of the library's computer hardware and software

Library staff assumes that children and young adults under the age of 18 who are unattended while in the library have parental permission to use its resources, including the internet.

Library staff reserves the right to terminate a patron's computer use session if they observe any behavior that they judge in conflict with the library's Computer Use Policy.
